MultiTech is no newcomer to this market; in the early days of the Internet their modems were the de-facto standard for ISPs if you wanted to keep your dial-up customers connected. They show their expertise and knowledge in the details of this fax server product.

Enterprise level facilities will notice the benefits of the FaxFinder FF200 appliance with the ability to send any printable document as a fax. The Windows-based client application performs on-the-fly capture of a printed

documents, prompts the user for fax addressing information and sends the converted document to the FaxFinder device. It also allows the user to schedule the release of the documents at a specific time, which allows for a unified release of information. Received faxes are in a digital format and sent to specific email addresses based on the DID phone number information. This is a key benefit especially when the fax contains sensitive information.



The FaxFinder FF200 model includes two connections for use with analog phone lines. When connected to your corporate PBX phone system, the appliance allows fax communications from incoming callers and the ability to send faxes over regular phone lines. DTMF information provided by the PBX will be used to route incoming faxes to their proper destinations.

Configuration of the FaxFinder FF200 appliance is rather straightforward and is accomplished through a web browser-based application. The web management interface allows you to monitor fax usage and manage FaxFinder users. A Windows-based administration application is provided to allow easy feature upgrades and synchronization of phone book information between multiple FaxFinder devices.

MultiTech Systems produces four different models of the FaxFinder appliance. Variations of the product depend on the number of analog telephone ports that are connected to the unit and can range from one, two, four or eight ports. The FF200 model provides access to two analog telephone lines. A single 10/100Base-T Ethernet port provides the necessary access to your local area network.
